- Responsible for reporting any concerns with the electronic systems to the Chief Electrical Engineer and Technical Operations Communications Manager.
- The Electronic Engineer Jr. / Communication must be familiar with safety routines and ensure that the necessary safeguards are in place before any maintenance/repair work commences.
- Must be familiar with Class Rules and industry standards and the implication of any modifications to electrical systems.
- Performs other related duties as assigned or as directed. The omission of specific duties does not preclude the supervisor from assigning duties that are logically related to the position.
- Must be familiar with the Safety and Environmental Protection Policy and the SEMS, and carry out
 the policies and procedures appropriate for his/her position.
