## **Job Description | Requirements**

The medical team on board consists of 1 or 2 highly experienced and skilled physicians and 3 or 4 highly experienced and skilled registered nurses, depending upon the size of the vessel. All medical staff at a minimum is BLS (Basic Life Support), ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) and PALS (Pediatric Advanced Life Support) certified. We maintain a skill mix, which suits the needs of each vessel, and in doing so; we endeavor to provide consistently high standards of care and medical knowledge within the medical centers on board.

**The ship's physician** is the head of the medical department onboard and is each crewmember's primary care physician. She/he is also responsible for the health care given to each guest who attends the Medical Center for medical issues. The physician is responsible for maintaining registration with his/her own licensing body. The physician is responsible to the Captain as well as the shore side fleet medical director. The ship's physician must be competent to perform the following:

- Evaluation and treatment of medical, surgical, gynecological and pediatric problems
- Suturing of wounds
- Incision and drainage of abscesses
- Interpretation of electrocardiograms
- Reduction of simple dislocations. Splinting and immobilization procedures.
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support procedures and treatments (ACLS); including emergency airway management
- Evaluation of ophthalmologic emergencies
- Administration of thrombolytic agents
- Basic x-ray interpretation
- Proficiency in English speaking and writing.
- A minimum of 3 years' experience in the Emergency department or ICU with high level knowledge of advanced care medical equipment eg: defibrillators, ventilator, Cpap, Bi-pap, etc.
- Certifications: valid Advanced cardiac life support and basic life support, for all Dr's PALS (pediatric advanced life support certification)
