### 3.0 Job Summary

- In charge of performing maintenance on firefighting, fire prevention and life saving equipment
- Perform maintenance as instructed by the Chief Fire Patrol
- Perform fire watches as instructed
- Respond to fire emergencies as needed
- Any other assignments as required by the Chief Fire Patrol and/or Staff Captain/Safety Officer

### 4.0 Responsibility and authority: He/she will be responsible for:

- Assist the Chief Fire Patrol in identify routine maintenance to be performed on the firefighting/fire detection system
- Ensures fire station and lockers are stowed with the required equipment and are in good order
- Identify risk areas and ensure fire risk is minimized
- Take part in drills and exercises as required
- Perform routine maintenance on the vessel life saving appliances as instructed
- Ensure that all aspects of company's OH&S are effectively applied during his/her working activities
- Supervise and Perform Laundry and Galleys Cleaning
- Back stage services
- Any other assignment as required by the Staff Captain or by Safety Officer or by the Chief Fire Patrol
