- The Second Engineer must be watch qualified and able to take over the watch or stand watch as manning may require.
- If any operational problems occur with the equipment, the Second Engineer must report and work closely with the vessel's Electrical Engineers and 1st Engineer to resolve these issues
- Shall be familiar with the safety management system, including specific responsibilities in the safety organization according to the emergency plan and station bill.
- Must be familiar with the Safety and Environmental Protection Policy and the SEMS, and carry out the policies and procedures applicable for subject position.
- Performs other related duties as assigned or as directed. The omission of specific duties does
 not preclude the supervisor from assigning duties that are logically related to the position.
