

Job description for onboard musician.

The musician has to play piano music...

...on embarkation day:

- Between 1 pm to 3 pm
- For welcome cocktail until diner starts
- Right after diner until all passengers left the lounge (in case there is no other onboard entertainment)

...on regular days:

- During tea time
- At least one hour before diner until diner starts (in case there is no other onboard entertainment)
- Right after diner until all passengers left the lounge (in case there is no other onboard entertainment)

The actual times of tea time and diner and scheduled onboard entertainment have to be checked by the musician in the daily program.

The musician has to play even if there is only a single passenger in the lounge.

The musician has to accomplish the following side jobs:

- Clear all lounge tables when diner started and in the end of the night.
- Clean and polish the glasses.
- Help with decorating the lounge for themed parties.
- Help with loadings.
- Help with the luggage in case he is not playing at that time.

If you as the hotelmanager make your own agreement together with the musician about the side jobs, this is ok and up to you, if these are only a small changes and the changes do not cause unfairness to other crewmembers.

Playing times are not debatable; they have to be followed as they are required by the owner.
